The Gathering of delegates in Rome : 20-22 November 2015 CASA LA SALLE, L'ospitalità a Roma, Via Aurelia, 472 , 00165 Roma, Italy

As the apostles and the followers of Jesus did in Jerusalem (Act. 15, 2-4), delegates from associations, networks, parishes, communities and individuals who agreed to contribute to the project Council 50 throughout the world will meet **from 20 till 22 November 2015 in Rome at Casa La Salle.**

They are also invited to the colloquium organized **in the same place from 11 till 17 November 2015** in Rome by the Institut für Theologie und Politik in cooperation with Council 50 in order to **renew and update the commitments of the Pact of Catacombs and relight the flame of Council Vatican II (see the document of presentation).**

During these meetings, these delegates and individual participants will:

- share their experiences and their reflections, to know each other better thanks to **a fair'' to associations, groups and communities** allowing them to present what they are and what they do,
- think at the future of the Church and about the implication of her members in the transformation of the world, thanks to
 - a report on the contributions received presented by Dr. Nontando Hadebe a layman woman theologian of South Africa and Zimbabwe,
 - presentations of delegates from different parts of the world on issues, expectations and proposals of their regions,
 - the works during two series of workshops on the points of the charter,
- draft and adopt a Charter, the Charter Council50, which will present the reforms which they will propose from their experience and reflection. The conclusions of the colloquium and the charter Council 50 will enrich themselves mutually. This Charter will be submitted to the pope during the celebration of the fiftieth anniversary of the close of Council Vatican II
- build-up a lively network of correspondents worldwide, that will allow the exchanges and brotherly confrontations necessary for the discernment for an authentic life of Church and of Christians in our evolving world, since as father Joseph Moingt says, the search for the Truth must be democratic.
- meet in St Peter's square.
